The Oral History Association's 2026 Annual Meeting will be held at the Hilton Portland Downtown at 921 SW 6<sup>th</sup> Ave., Portland, Oregon, 97204.

Landscapes of Memory is the theme of the 2026 Oral History Association Annual Meeting in Portland, Oregon, inviting participants from around the world to explore how people shape and are shaped by the places they inhabit, move through, defend, and are sometimes forced to leave behind. Set against the Pacific Northwest's rich history of environmental leadership, Indigenous stewardship, creative activism, and community resilience, the conference will highlight stories of land, memory, movement, and belonging amid environmental, political, and cultural change. Through interdisciplinary and community-centered approaches, the meeting will examine displacement, ecological knowledge, digital storytelling, foodways, and environmental justice, while showcasing innovative formats such as workshops, performances, and multimedia presentations that connect local and global experiences.
